- **Eligibility:** Applicants should have begun their appointment as an independent investigator at the assistant professor level on or after May 1, 2022. The appointment must be their first tenure-track position (or its nearest equivalent) at an invited institution. Focus areas include: biochemistry, cell biology, genetics, immunology, neuroscience, pharmacology, and related areas in chemistry, medicine, and the biological sciences.
- **Required Internal Application Materials:**
  - Cover page (1 page maximum) with Principal Investigator name, rank and affiliation as well as submitting unit. Include the title of the proposed research and major areas of doctoral and post-doctoral research. List the names, work title, department and institution of the three non-Notre Dame letters of support you will request should you be selected as the institutional nominee. Include a statement that you meet the eligibility requirements.
  - A current biosketch (5 page maximum) that includes the following: A personal statement of up to 500 words that justifies your selection as the nominee Education, Positions, Other experience, Honors/Awards, Publications, Current Funding, and Pending Grants.
  - Summary of proposed research and its significance (1 page maximum) References are optional and do not count toward page limits.
