Mission: The ambition of the [Frontiers Planet Prize](#) is to directly address the planetary crisis, by mobilizing scientists engaged in breakthrough research, with the greatest potential to stabilize the planet's ecosystem. "The Prize will be made" to the best research published in established peer-reviewed scientific journals, with robust peer review and transparent publication procedures." **The acceptance date of the article must fall within the 2 years prior to the launch of the competition (1 November 2023 to 31 October 2025).** Viable candidates are most likely to have published their research in Science, Nature, and/or PNAS or a peer-reviewed publication of similar magnitude.
